### Instructions / Guidelines to Gold Medal & Ph.D. Degree Recipients

The candidates are informed to note the following Convocation procedure:

### For Gold Medal Recipients:

- All the Gold medal recipients are informed to collect their ENTRY PASS and ADMIT CARD from their Principal Office / Head of the Department from 2<sup>nd</sup> July to 05<sup>th</sup> July during 11.00 a.m. to 05.00 p.m.
- All the Gold Medal recipients are requested to collect their Medals and Certificates from the designated counter located at University College of Engineering and Technology for Women, KU between 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM on the day of the convocation. Please bring a valid ID card for verification.
- After collecting the medal, please proceed to the photography area for a group photo session with fellow recipients.
- Kindly follow the instructions provided by the event coordinators for smooth organization.
- Dress Code is Mandatory; follow the guidelines as specified under.

# For Ph.D. Degree Recipients:

- All the Ph.D. recipients are informed to collect their ENTRY PASS and ADMIT CARD from the Examination Branch, Kakatiya University (E5 Section Counter No. 7 SBI ATM Backside) by showing the required evidence (Payment Evidence and Press Note) from 2<sup>nd</sup> July to 05<sup>th</sup> July during 11.00 a.m. to 05.00 p.m.
- At most one accompanied person shall be allowed inside the Convocation Hall.
   The family members and well-wishers of the Ph.D. graduates can watch the live-streaming.
- Seats shall be occupied by the members/students and their accompanying guests/family members ONE HOUR before the start of Proceedings.
- Members are also required to stand up at the time of administering the "Oath".

#### Guidelines to follow by the Ph. D. Degree & Gold Medal Recipients:

- During the function, mobile phones should be kept switched off.
- Personal photography and selfies are prohibited.
- The official photographer shall carry out photography and videography during the ceremony. Photographs of awardees can be ordered from these designated photographers afterwards.
- No person shall be allowed to attend the Convocation as a representative of the member. If a person abstains from attending the Convocation, his/her original certificate and / or gold medal will be sent by post at the mailing address registered in the records of the University.
- The following items are prohibited during the ceremony: camera, whistles, water bottle or any liquids, balloons, wrapped gifts, weapons, knife, sharp objects, food, alcohol, etc.
- Bring one photo ID proof (Passport/Voter I-card/Aadhaar Card/ Driving License/
  ID Card/PAN Card, etc.) for registration at the venue and for allowing entry into
  the Convocation Hall.
- Children below 12 years are not allowed.
- Security measures prohibit carry-in items.
- Coats, trousers, purses and other items are subject to inspection.
- Vehicles shall be parked in assigned parking area only.
- Awardees must come to the venue wearing the specified Indian attire/dress which is as under:
  - White Formal Dress for Male and Female Candidates.
  - Female candidates may wear White Saree with White Blouse / White Kurtas with White Churidars.
  - Shoes/ Sandals are acceptable.
  - Students in informal Dress (like Jeans etc.) or with Footwear other than the above mentioned will not be allowed into the Auditorium.

#### Dos and Don'ts

Strictly adhere to the following Do's and Don'ts at the time of Convocation and show your respect to your Alma-Mater and your Nation.

Convocation is a serene and ceremonial function. It is the responsibility of all of us to maintain utmost decorum and discipline.



- Occupy your allotted seat in the Auditorium positively by 9.30 AM.
- Please stand up while the academic procession enters the Auditorium and remain standing until the Invocation is over.
- Please stand up from your seat while the academic procession leaves after the function.
- Maintain strict silence while the Vice-Chancellor, Chief Guest and Chancellor delivering their speech.
- Maintain discipline and decorum of the ceremony.



- Do not enter the Auditorium after the academic procession has arrived into the Auditorium. Please note that by doing so, you are showing your disrespect for the entire event.
- Do not move around in the Auditorium during the entire duration of the ceremony.
- Do not whistle in the Auditorium.
